WHO ARE WE? The BMW Touring Club of NSW was established in 1965 and has grown from an initial 15 members. We are a diverse group with a common enjoyment of riding motorcycles. Membership to the club is open to all motorcyclists, ownership of a BMW motorcycle is not essential.

Historically the club has revolved around rallies, camping and touring. Events in our newsletter range from day rides (lower Hunter, the Southern Highlands and the Blue Mountains) to weekend runs (Central West, north or south coasts) and rallies (such as the Thunder, Loaded Dog, Alpine and Kosciuszko). We also have events to meet with other BMW clubs including the annual National Motorrad Rally. The more adventurous can participate in dirt touring, giving the opportunity to attend events such as the bi-annual BMW meet (OCR), where owners from all over the country attend what is usually an out of the way place such as Mount Augustus, the Kimberly in W.A., Stonehenge in QLD., or Mount Dare in S.A. Where on the way you could experience places like the Devil's Marbles, Flinders Ranges and the Gulf country to name but a few.

We try to cater for all types of riders and riding while encouraging all members and their families to take an active role in events. Any member can recommend or create an event with this being actively encouraged in to give everyone a voice, and to help bring variety to the club.

Please Note - Some members prefer to ride bitumen, others dirt, but all are encouraged to ride within their own competence and arrive at the destination. New members are always welcome, especially at rallies with senior members actively looking to provide support and advice if asked.
